Call to Order: Dr. Dorsey called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

I. **Approval of Meeting Minutes – September 12, 2024**

Motion to approve minutes was put forth by Sabrina Tyuse and seconded by Scott Sell. Minutes were approved by the committee.

II. **Academic Programs: INTO SLU Pathway into Major.**

Dr. Dorsey provided a summary of Lisa Fischer’s proposal to the UAAC committee – An academic threshold was established in the origination of the matriculation process for pathway students that was thought necessary to get them successfully through the process. Since that time, some students have had to repeat and stay longer than students not on the pathway. Some of these same students had over a 3.0 GPA.

A review of academic outcomes indicated that a revision in INTO SLU pathway matriculation standards into major should be revised to the same standards as non-pathway students. The first paragraph of the proposal is a summary, and the last two sentences discuss the need to move to a parody.

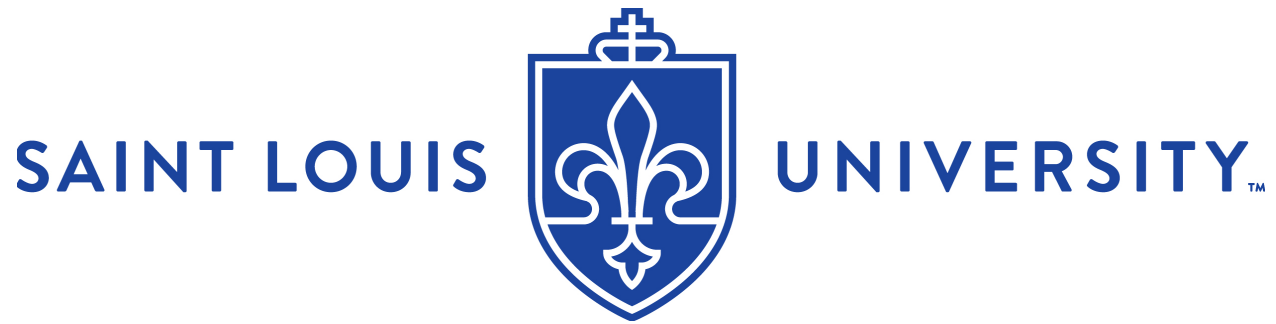
